Lansdsowne Dave's Birthday 05/02/38 - died January 2021

On Saturday 5 Feb 1938 it was the opening of the 3rd British Empire Games (now Commonwealth games) in Sydney, Australia. United drew 1-1 at Stockport County with a goal from Jock Dodds

The 1937/38 season both Utd (3rd) & Wed (17th) in Div 2, won by Man Utd, Villa 2nd.

25 June 1938 Douglas Hyde is formally inaugurated as the first President of Ireland

In 1938 the big films included "Angels with Dirty Faces" (James Cagney & Humphrey Bogart), "The Adventures of Robin Hood" (Errol Flynn) and Walt Disney's "Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs"

Two top songs in the UK were "The Biggest Aspidistra In The World" and "Boomps-A-Daisy", in USA the top songs were Artie Shaw "Begin the Beguine", Bob Hope & Shirley Ross "Thanks For the Memory", Seven Dwarfs "Whistle While You Work" The Andrews Sisters "Bei Mir Bist Du Schoen", Fred Astaire "Nice Work If You Can Get It"

The top three films in 1954 were Alfred Hitchcock's Rear Window; White Christmas starring Bing Crosby and Danny Kaye and Disney's 20,000 Leagues Under the Sea

On 8 February 1962 when Barry became a man (21)

Number 1 in the charts was "The Young Ones" by Cliiff Richard and the Shadows. Other Number 1s in 1962 were B. Bumble and the Stingers "Nut Rocker"; Mike Sarne with Wendy Richard "Come Outside" and Frank Ifield "I Remember You".

Top 1962 films were "West Side Story", "A Kind of Loving", "The Man who Shot Liberty Valance", The Loneliness of the Long Distance Runner", "Dr No" (the first Bond Film), "The Longest Day", "How the West was won", and "Lawrence of Arabia". TV programmes that first started in 1962 include "Z Cars", "Steptoe and Son" "The Saint" starring Roger Moore, "That Was The Week That Was" and "University Challenge",
